

## **St. Vincent de Paul Catholic School Sports Participation Policy**

1. During the first week of tryouts, the coach will confer with the teachers regarding eligibility.
2. On the Monday after the first week of tryouts and on each Monday throughout the playing season, the teachers will give the coach current grades for each player.
3. If any student has an F in any subject on any grade report, he/she will enter a two week probationary period. During this time, he/she will continue to practice and play in games.
4. If any student has a grade point average below 1.8 (11 grade points: A=4, B=3, C=2, D=1) on any grade report, he/she will enter a two-week probationary period. During this time, he/she will continue to practice and play in games.
5. If after the two weeks the student has either a failing grade in any subject or a grade point average less than 1.8, he/she will lose eligibility to play. Ineligibility will continue on a week-to-week basis until all grades are passing and the grade point average is at least 1.8.
6. A student may become ineligible because of his or her conduct grade. Conduct grades lower than a C- for two weeks in a row will result in probation.
7. If a student is placed on probation or becomes ineligible, a letter will be sent home to be signed by the parent or guardian and returned to the school office.
